HERO MOTOCORP DONATES UNIQUE FIRST RESPONDER VEHICLE (FRV) TO HEALTH AUTHORITIES IN PUNJAB

As part of its ongoing Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives towards the COVID-19 relief efforts, **Hero MotoCorp**, the world's largest manufacturer of motorcycles and scooters, donated a specially designed First Responder Vehicle (FRV) to the health authorities in Jagraon, Ludhiana.

Hero MotoCorp handed over FRV to Dr. Pradeep Mahindra, Senior Medical Officer, Jagraon in the presence of Shri Charanjit Singh Sohal, Senior Superintendent of Police and Shri Narinder Singh Dhaliwal, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Jagraon, Ludhiana.

These unique and utilitarian vehicles will be useful for reaching out to patients in the rural and remote areas and comfortably moving them to the nearest hospitals. These FRVs have been custom-built as an accessory on the powerful **Xtreme 200R motorcycles** of Hero MotoCorp.

The FRVs have been equipped with a full stretcher with a foldable hood mounted on the side, essential medical equipment such as a detachable first-aid kit, oxygen cylinder, fire extinguisher and other safety features such as LED Flasher Lights, foldable beacon light, emergency wireless public announcement system and siren.

In addition to FRV, Hero MotoCorp also donated 500 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Kits along with 5,000 face masks to the health authorities.

Commenting on this occasion, **Mr. Vijay Sethi, Chief Information Officer, Chief Human Resources Officer; and Head - Corporate Social Responsibility, Hero MotoCorp**, said, *"In keeping with our relief efforts to fight the COVID-19 pandemic, Hero MotoCorp has been providing First Responder Vehicles (FRVs) to front-line health personnel in different states to assist patients in rural and remote areas. Designed and developed by the engineers at our R&D facility – the Centre for Innovation and Technology (CIT) in Jaipur - and the New Model Centre (NMC) in Gurgaon, the FRV is fitted with all the necessary medical equipment that offers urgent assistance to patients who require to be transported to the hospital."*

Till date, Hero MotoCorp handed over 49 FRVs to the government authorities in various states, including Haryana, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Jammu and Himachal Pradesh.
