

Covid cases in Delhi drop below 1,000 after 44 days

DELHI REPORTED 977 fresh Covid cases Friday, recording a daily tally of less than 1,000 after a period of 44 days, as per the daily health bulletin released by the Delhi government. The positivity rate also dropped below the 2% mark to 1.73% Friday.

A positivity rate of less than 2% was recorded for the first time in 42 days as per the data. A Covid outbreak is thought to be under control when a positivity rate below 5% is maintained for more than two weeks, according to the World Health Organisation. The number of cases and positivity rate has been steadily declining despite the government lifting restrictions such as weekend curfew, closure of schools, colleges, and gyms.

The current surge of cases, which was the fifth for Delhi and third for the country, waxed and waned quickly in the capital. The number of fresh cases reported each day remained more than 1,000 consecutively for a period of 44 days during the current surge. In comparison, it remained over the 1,000-mark consecutively for 59 days during the previous surge of cases in

April-May last year.

"This current surge of cases was for a short duration as I had predicted before. This is because over 95% of Delhi residents have already been exposed to the virus. This was also the reason we saw fewer deaths this time around," said Dr Jugal Kishore, head of the department of community medicine at Safdarjung Hospital.

"It is time for life to go back to normal. We have to treat it just like H1N1. We have it seasonally but no one is too bothered about it," said Dr Kishore.

He added, there was a need to remain prepared for any other variant of Sars-CoV-2 or other viral infections. "We have seen several pathogens jumping from animals to human beings over

the last 20 to 30 years and we will see more and the interactions between humans and animals increase. We have to be prepared. We have to strengthen our sub-centres and primary health centres, create oxygen beds close to people. We have around 1.25 lakh sub-centres across India and 35,000 primary health centres. If all of them were well equipped, people would not rush to hubs such as Delhi where oxygen was in short supply. We have to prepare now so that in case some outbreak happens, the protocols can be activated," he said.

There have been 1.84 million cases and 26,047 Covid deaths in the capital since the pandemic began in 2020.

Govt to scale down Covid beds after ensuring no surge in cases when schools, colleges reopen

THE DELHI government is likely to start scaling down the number of beds earmarked for the treatment of Covid, according to officials in the know of the matter. At present, there are around 15,000 beds earmarked for Covid patients across government and private hospitals in the capital.

Despite a consistent decline in cases from January third week and a positivity rate of less than 5% over the last 10 days, the government shied away from releasing beds for the treatment of other ailments. "All the restrictions are being lifted now and even schools and colleges are reopening. We want to wait and watch whether there is an uptick in cases. We wanted to be cautious. The de-escalation process will likely begin by next week, but even then it will be in a phased manner just like it was scaled up,"

said a senior government official. There were just over 3,000 beds earmarked for the treatment of the infection in government hospitals and temporary facilities such as the ones being run on Ramliha Maidan by the government. Almost all the beds in private sector hospitals were being used for treatment of other ailments with the hospitals hardly seeing any Covid cases after the massive wave of infections in April-May last year.

When the city saw an increase in dengue cases in October and November last year, 20% out of the 30% of beds officially reserved for Covid in the private sector were diverted for its treatment.

The bed strength in the government sector was increased to 4,300 and private hospitals were asked to reserve 40% of their total beds during the first week of January. The number of beds across hospitals was increased to over 12,000 by January second week and to 14,000 by January

by which time the cases had already started going down.

Even at the peak of the current wave, with cases surging to the same level as the previous wave, bed occupancy remained low. The hospitalisations peaked at 2,734 on January 19 for the current wave, with hospital occupancy remaining at less than 20%.

The Delhi health minister said after the delta variant-driven wave, the government had prepared for over 35,000 hospital and step-down health centres. He said, less than 15,000 beds were released because the hospitalisations weren't high.

Even though officially all private hospitals are to keep 40% earmarked for Covid, many have already started using them. "Over the two years, we have learned how to quickly convert wards for Covid so if there is a surge we can go back to treating Covid patients. But for now, there are others in need of treatment," said an official from a private hospital.

SON WAS AT THE WHEEL, HIT BUSINESSMAN: POLICE

Law student held, his retd bureaucrat father booked for GK hit-and-run

A 27-YEAR-OLD law student has been arrested for allegedly hitting a businessman with his car and dragging him on the bonnet in South Delhi's Greater Kailash 1 on Tuesday. Police said his father, a retired IAS officer, has also been booked for allegedly harbouring his son.

Raj Sundaram, who was allegedly driving the vehicle, a Volkswagen T-Roc, studies at a leading private university in Gurgaon. According to police,

initial probe has revealed he does not have a licence.

The incident took place around 6 pm Tuesday and CCTV footage purportedly shows Raj driving the newly purchased vehicle and dragging the victim on the bonnet for over 100 metres before the man falls to the road and the car drives off.

The family of the man, Anant Vijay Mandelia (37), said he sustained multiple injuries on his head and is admitted at Max Hospital, Saket. He runs a hydroponics business and lives with his family in GK-1.

DCP (South district) Benita

Mary Jaiker said, "Initially, a case

under sections of rash driving and causing grievous hurt was registered. New sections have now been added on the basis of facts that emerged during investigation. The accused was arrested outside Le Meridien Hotel in Gurgaon and is facing charges under IPC sections 307 (attempt to murder) and 308 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder). We have also arrested Raj's father, Pandyan Kalyan Sundaram, who retired from the post of joint secretary in the petroleum ministry. He was booked under IPC section 212

(harbouring)."

Police said they received a call about the hit-and-run incident and, after talking to witnesses, found that a mustard Volkswagen had hit Mandelia outside his house. Police checked CCTV footage in the locality and traced the vehicle.

"Police reached Raj's house, from where they recovered the vehicle. He and his father were missing. Using technical surveillance, the father and son, who were communicating with their relatives and advocates via WhatsApp, were arrested from Le Meridien Hotel,"

an officer said.

According to police, during questioning, Raj initially told investigators his father was at the wheel. Police, however, claim to have found CCTV footage which shows Raj getting out from the driver's side and his father from the passenger side.

"We have also recovered several video clips from his phone of his car's speedometer... showing a speed of over 120km/hr. The locations suggest these videos were recorded in different areas of South Delhi," said an officer, adding that the car was purchased by Raj's father.

Rash driving in area a constant concern: Kin, residents

RASH DRIVING has been a constant issue in the Greater Kailash 1 area where businessman Anant Mandelia (37) was hit by a car and dragged for some distance on its bonnet, his family as well as residents claimed.

A family member, who asked not to be identified, said Mandelia's condition was stable though he has not yet regained consciousness. He claimed Anant was trying to stop the accused from driving rashly when he was hit by the vehicle.

Mandelia runs a hydroponics business, and the family has been living in the area for a long time, according to neighbours.

The section of the road where the incident took place is wide and begins at a three-way

intersection and concludes at a dead-end. It is flanked by homes on both sides, one of them being Mandelia's.

Vinod (35), who goes by his first name and works as a driver at a home close to Mandelia's, was out on the street when the incident happened. "The businessman would walk here sometimes... that evening, he was standing on the road. The car sped past and turned around and I saw Mandelia on the bonnet, holding on to the wiper, even as the driver drove on... He fell off and the car sped away. We have seen it here before," he said.

Nitin Thakur, another driver in the area, said, "I heard somebody shouting and came out to see Mandelia falling and the car driving away immediately. He was bleeding, and the family's driver, who was outside, took him to the hospital."

A day before the incident, Vinod said police barricades had been placed near the dead end. After Tuesday, the barricades were shifted to the intersection, forcing vehicles to slow down. "Vehicles tend to speed here," he added.

A 43-year-old woman who lives nearby, requesting anonymity, claimed she had seen a yellow car speeding on the road a day before the incident and tried to stop it. "They did not stop. It is a wide residential road and rash driving is a

concern here. Residents come here with their children to cycle since it's a dead end. In fact, Mandelia was trying to talk to the RWA to get barricades put up and speed breakers made so that vehicles slow down," she said.

Arun Vohra, president of the GK-1 B-Block RWA, claimed they had filed police complaints earlier, but no action was taken. "That stretch of around half a km is a secluded one, and it's a very wide road. Rash driving is a big problem there," he said.

However, a police officer said they had not received any complaints of rash driving or speeding from locals. "The matter came to light only after the incident."

Mandelia has also been associated with the RWA, though he was not a member, and the issue has been brought to the association's notice, Vohra added.

दिल्ली उच्च न्यायालय ने कहा

दो मार्च से अदालतों में पहले की तरह कामकाज शुरू

नई दिल्ली, 11 फरवरी (भाषा)।

दिल्ली उच्च न्यायालय ने शुक्रवार को कहा कि वह 2 मार्च से पहले की तरह कामकाज फिर से शुरू करेगा, जबकि मामला-दर-मामला आधार पर असाधारण परिस्थितियों में 'हाइब्रिड' या डिजिटल सुनवाई की अनुमति होगी। उच्च न्यायालय ने एक प्रशासनिक आदेश में सभी हितधारकों को जल्द से जल्द खुद को कोरोना से बचाव का टीका लगाने की सलाह दी और कहा कि इस बीच, केवल उचित संख्या में पीठ ही भौतिक अदालतें आयोजित करेंगी।

एक अलग प्रशासनिक आदेश में, उच्च न्यायालय ने सूचित किया कि शहर की जिला अदालतें भी 2 मार्च से पूरी तरह से फिर से शुरू होने के साथ अगले सप्ताह से इसी तरह क्रमिक रूप से पहले की तरह सुनवाई शुरू करेंगी। जिला अदालतों से संबंधित आदेश में कहा गया, 'सभी प्रधान जिला और सत्र न्यायाधीश और प्रधान न्यायाधीश, परिवार न्यायालय (मुख्यालय) अपने-अपने जिलों/परिवार न्यायालयों के न्यायिक अधिकारियों का एक रoster इस तरह से

तैयार करेंगे कि 14 फरवरी 2022 से न्यायिक अधिकारियों की कुल शक्ति का लगभग 50 फीसद भौतिक रूप से अदालत में हो जबकि अन्य मामलों पर डिजिटल माध्यम से सुनवाई हो।' उच्च न्यायालय ने दो आदेशों में स्पष्ट किया, 'उपरोक्त व्यवस्था (सीमित भौतिक पीठ द्वारा सुनवाई) 28 फरवरी 2022 तक जारी रहेगी और दो मार्च 2022 से भौतिक सुनवाई की पूर्ण बहाली होगी। भौतिक सुनवाई की पूर्ण बहाली के बाद, अदालतें, असाधारण परिस्थितियों में मामला-दर-मामला आधार पर हाइब्रिड, वीडियो-कांफ्रेंस के जरिए सुनवाई की अनुमति दें।'



उच्च न्यायालय ने कारोबारी नवनीत कालरा को विदेश जाने की अनुमति दी

नई दिल्ली, 11 फरवरी (भाषा)।

दिल्ली उच्च न्यायालय ने कोविड-19 की दूसरी लहर के दौरान आक्सीजन सांद्रक (कंसंट्रेटर्स) की कथित कालाबाजारी के मामले में आरोपी कारोबारी नवनीत कालरा को विदेश जाने की शुरुआत को अनुमति दे दी। अदालत ने 50 लाख रुपए की प्रतिभूति राशि (सिक्कुरिटी डिपोजिट) जमा करने की शर्त पर संबंधित उद्योग के दो आयोजनों में शामिल होने के लिए विदेश जाने की इजाजत दी है।

न्यायमूर्ति योगेश खन्ना ने कहा कि प्रतिभूति राशि जमा करने के अलावा याचिकाकर्ता को एक हलफनामा (अंडरटेकिंग) देने का निर्देश दिया गया है कि उसकी याचिका को सुनवाई लंबित रहने के दौरान वह एजेंसी द्वारा जब्त अपनी कोई संपत्ति नहीं बेचेंगे। एकल पीठ धनशोधन मामले में कालरा के खिलाफ लुकआउट सर्कुलर (एलओसी) को चुनौती देने वाली याचिका की सुनवाई कर रही थी। याचिकाकर्ता ने दुबई और

50 लाख रुपए की प्रतिभूति राशि होगी जमा

एजेंसी द्वारा जब्त संपत्ति नहीं बेचने का हलफनामा देना जरूरी

इटली के मिलान में आयोजित होने वाली चरमों की दो प्रदर्शनियों में हिस्सा लेने के लिए प्रवर्तन निदेशालय द्वारा धनशोधन मामले में जारी एलओसी को निलंबित करने की मांग की थी।

अदालत ने केंद्र सरकार को तीन दिन के भीतर यह बताने के लिए भी कहा है कि क्या याचिकाकर्ता के खिलाफ आक्षेपित एलओसी के अलावा भी कोई अन्य एलओसी जारी किया गया है। न्यायमूर्ति खन्ना ने ईडी तथा केंद्र सरकार को इस याचिका पर अपना जवाब दाखिल करने का निर्देश दिया है और मामले की सुनवाई के लिए 17 अगस्त की तारीख निर्धारित की है। इससे पहले ईडी के वकील आशीष जैन ने याचिकाकर्ता को कोई भी राहत दिए जाने का पुरजोर विरोध किया था।

आज लगेगी बिजली मामलों पर विशेष अदालत

उत्तरी एवं उत्तर-पश्चिमी दिल्ली के उपभोक्ताओं को बिजली की आपूर्ति करने वाली बिजली वितरण कंपनी टाटा पावर-डीडीएल (टीपीडीडीएल) बिजली चोरी और कनेक्शन काटने के मामलों का मौके पर ही निपटारा करने के लिए शनिवार को विशेष लोक अदालत लगाएगी। यह लोक अदालत दिल्ली राज्य कानूनी सेवा प्राधिकरण (डीएसएलएसए) के सहयोग से और सुबह 10 बजे से शाम 4 बजे तक लगेगी। ये सत्र माता सुंदरी लेन पर स्थायी लोक अदालत में, रोहिणी के सेक्टर-3 में टाटा पावर-डीडीएल के ईएसी कार्यालय में और आनलाइन दोनों तरह से आयोजित किए जाएंगे। कंपनी के मुताबिक, सुरक्षा के मद्देनजर वादियों को सलाह दी गई है कि वे लोक अदालत से पहले 19124 फोन नंबर पर काल करके या ईमेल करके अपना पंजीकरण कराएं। लोक अदालत में उन मामलों पर सुनवाई की जाएगी जो या तो किसी अदालत में लंबित हैं।

जेएनयू छात्र संघ ने कुलपति से कहा

नियमित कक्षाओं के लिए नहीं हुई उचित व्यवस्था

जवाहर लाल नेहरू विश्वविद्यालय (जेएनयू) के छात्र संघ ने शुक्रवार को नवनियुक्त कुलपति शांतिश्री धुलिपुडी पंडित को बताया कि विश्वविद्यालय में नियमित कक्षाएं फिर से शुरू करने के लिए उचित व्यवस्था नहीं की गई है। जेएनयू छात्र संघ ने कुलपति को छात्रावासों की खस्ता हालत से अवगत कराते हुए कहा कि कक्षाओं के दौरान शारीरिक दूरी सुनिश्चित करने के लिए कक्षाओं की संख्या अपर्याप्त है। छात्र संघ ने एक बयान जारी कर कहा कि छात्र संघ की अध्यक्ष आइशी घोष और संयुक्त सचिव मोहम्मद दानिश ने कुलपति पंडित से मुलाकात की और विभिन्न मुद्दों पर विस्तृत चर्चा की। जेएनयू छात्र संघ ने छात्र समुदाय की चिंताओं पर 15 सूत्री एक विस्तृत ज्ञापन भी कुलपति को सौंपा।

बलात्कार के मामले में नौसेना का अधिकारी बरी

दिल्ली की अदालत ने भारतीय नौसेना में कार्यरत अधिकारी को बलात्कार के मामले से बरी कर दिया है। अदालत ने यह फैसला कथित पीड़िता द्वारा बार-बार बयान बदलने के आधार पर दिया। अतिरिक्त सत्र न्यायाधीश अंकुर जैन ने यह संज्ञान में लिया कि बलात्कार का आरोप लगाने वाली महिला ने तीन अलग-अलग स्तर पर अलग-अलग बयान दिया जिसके आधार उन्होंने लेफ्टिनेंट कमांडर को संदेह का लाभ दिया। अदालत ने कहा, 'तीन अलग स्तर पर अभियोजन द्वारा तीन अलग-अलग संस्करण प्रस्तुत किए गए। गवाहों की गवाही में विरोधाभास, सुधार और विसंगति होनी लाजमी है। प्रत्येक विरोधाभास, सुधार और विसंगति महत्वपूर्ण नहीं है

लेकिन इस मामले में अभियोजन द्वारा पीड़िता के भाई की उपस्थिति को लेकर तीन अलग-अलग संस्करण प्रस्तुत किए गए।' अदालत ने कहा कि लगता है कि मौजूदा शिकायत आरोपी को शादी के लिए मजबूर करने के लिए की गई और जमानत अर्जी पर सुनवाई के दौरान आरोपी झुक गया और उसने महिला से शादी कर ली जो जमानत आदेश और रिकार्ड में मौजूद तस्वीरों से भी परिलक्षित होता है। अदालत ने माना कि अंततः यह शादी नहीं टिकी और दोनों ने तलाक ले लिया।

हिज्बुल के आठ आतंकवादियों के खिलाफ गिरफ्तारी वारंट जारी

नई दिल्ली, 11 फरवरी (एजेंसी)।

राजधानी की एक अदालत ने जम्मू-कश्मीर में आतंकवादियों और अलगाववादियों को धन मुहैया कराने से संबंधित धनशोधन मामले में कथित तौर पर हिज्बुल मुजाहिदीन के आठ आतंकवादियों के खिलाफ गैर जमानती गिरफ्तारी वारंट जारी किए हैं। अतिरिक्त सत्र न्यायाधीश प्रवीण सिंह ने प्रवर्तन निदेशालय की ओर से जारी याचिका पर गुलाम नबी खान, उमर फारूक शेरा, मंजूर

अहमद डार, जफर हुसैन भट, नाजिर अहमद डार, अब्दुल मजीद सोफी, मुबारक शाह और मोहम्मद युसुफ के खिलाफ गैर-जमानती वारंट (एनबीडब्ल्यू) जारी किए हैं। अदालत ने ईडी की ओर से पेश विशेष लोक अभियोजक नीतेश राणा की दलीलों का संज्ञान लिया कि इन आरोपियों को 2013 में ही भगोड़ा अपराधी घोषित कर दिया गया था। न्यायाधीश ने गत सात फरवरी को जारी अपने आदेश में कहा, 'इस प्रकार इस बात पर विश्वास करने का भरपूर आधार मौजूद है कि ये आरोपी समन का जवाब नहीं देंगे।
